



Health & Safety Policy Statement

General statement

The Air League (The Company) regards the health, safety and welfare of its employees and all its stakeholders, who may be affected by its activities, as being of prime importance.

The following statement recognises our obligations under the Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974, including all relevant regulations and approved codes of practice additional to the Act.

Organisation

The **Chief Executive Officer** has overall responsibility for ensuring that this policy is implemented and that adequate resources are allocated.

The Company recognises that this safety policy cannot be successful without the active participation of all members of staff and its content must be observed at all times.

Arrangements

The Company will conduct its activities in order to:

- provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities
- consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- provide and maintain a safe environment and equipment
- provide information, instruction and supervision for employees
- ensure all employees are competent and are given adequate training
- prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill-health
- maintain safe and healthy working conditions
- review and revise this policy statement as necessary at regular intervals.

This policy is supported by instructions, procedures and organisational arrangements and is to be applied to all activities carried out by the Company.

As part of an ongoing pro-active approach to health and safety management, the systems are reviewed regularly to ensure that they reflect the nature of the works being conducted.

The Company may, at its discretion, employ the services of a health and safety manager /advisor /officer /consultant, to provide expert knowledge and guidance to assist the Company in achieving and maintaining legal compliance.

The documents will have prescribed responsibilities for all managers and supervisors to ensure clarity and effective supervision with regards to health and safety management.
